

FOOD FRENZY RULES

The following explains the rules for counting non-perishable food and cash contributions to the Food Frenzy for The Food Bank of the Hudson Valley:

- The contest runs from November 14-18 2016. You may not count any money or food collected after November 18th.
- **Each dollar contributed will count as four pounds of food.**
- Checks should be made payable to: Food Bank of the Hudson Valley.
- Contributions of money are tax-deductible and are very welcome. Please note, if you are contributing cash, please include a receipt with the contributors name, address and amount of donation.
- You may donate online by going to our website, www.foodbankofthehudsonvalley.org and click the "donate now" button. When entering your gift, you must include the firm name and preference Food Frenzy.
- Food items will be weighed and the results tabulated in pounds.
- Candy will not be counted.
- When counting the number of employees, count each person working at the company, regardless of position.
- Please do not contribute food items in glass containers.
- Please do not open items that are already packed in cases, cartons, or boxes.
- If your firm delivers all food contributions to the Food Bank of the Hudson Valley at 195 Hudson Street, Cornwall-on-Hudson, New York your company will receive a 25% bonus of tabulated pounds!
- Firms with multiple office locations will compete as a single entity.
- All donations must be delivered on or before the close of business on November 20, 2015
- All non-perishable foods must be within sale date marked on package.
- All donations of food must be in boxes, sealed and labeled with the company name and address.
- Baby food will be acceptable if in plastic containers and within sale date.
